I Spring Sports

A. Badminton

1. Remind coaches to send game results to Brian King.
2. Brian reviewed the current League standings.

C. Boys Golf -- Today, April 4<sup>th</sup>, is the League Tournament at Paradise Valley.

D. Girls Soccer

1. Bob handed out mid-season summary of wins/losses for both the Varsity and J.V.
2. All League meeting will be May 5<sup>th</sup>, 6:00 p.m., room 9, Vacaville High School.
3. Coaches are interested in possibly going to a 10 game (double round robin) schedule.

E. Softball -- Brian reviewed current League standing.

F. Swimming / Diving

1. The League meet will be held at Vintage High. Each visiting school needs to notify Liza Saunders if their bus will remain at the site during the Friday trials.

## II Fall Sports

### A Football

### B. Volleyball

1. MEL will continue with triple round robin.
2. A coaches meeting will be called in August to review the 2008 season.
3. Heather asked if Scott Kostecka would do the Frosh League schedule for 2008.

### C. Water Polo – Joan will contact the SCAC commissioner in regards to which level and gender Benicia, Bethel, and Rodriquez plan to field for the fall 2008 season.

## III Winter Sports

### Basketball

1. Will SCAC be playing a 10-game League schedule next season? Joan will contact the SCAC commissioner.
2. For power ratings, the non-league cut-off will be Friday, January 9, 2009.
3. The Section will use a “Pilot” comparison program to determine ‘real’ strength of non-league games won. This program will allow the seeding committee to more accurately calculate League ratings.
4. The Section is again looking at increasing the “dead period” before each season to address some of the current loopholes of non coach contact and no equipment.
