A. Season 2

- 1. Baseball

 - c. All schools approved the schedule.
- 2. Softball
 - a. A new schedule was presented with one week having 3 games so that all league contests would end before graduation week.
 - b. All schools approved the proposed schedule.
- 1. Swimming/Diving
 - a. The schedule was presented with an adjustment that eliminated any 3 away in a row matches.
 - b. Vanden will be hosting all home games at Walter Graham Aquatic Center 1100 Alamo Dr. Vacaville.
 - c. All Schools approved proposed schedule.
- 2. Track
 - a. A new dual meet schedule was presented, which contains a bye week for any possible rainouts. The league track season will end with the two-day league tournament before graduation week.
 - b. All Schools approved the proposed schedule.
