II Fall Sports

A. Football

1. Fred reminded all ADs about the football practice specifics:
  - a. August 14 – conditioning on field begins with helmets only. No pads.
  - b. August 17 – Schools are *allowed only* 2 hours without equipment and *allowed only* 2 hours with full equipment. Note this is a total of 4 hours!
  - c. August 21 – Official “full gear” practice begins.
2. A pre-season coaches meeting will be called late August or early September. Fred will notify coaches of the meeting date, time and place.

B. Girls Golf

1. Armijo and Fairfield will not field girls teams.
2. A discussion was held regarding joining MEL and SCAC for scheduling of double round robin for the Fall season.
  - a. SCAC schools are fielding golf are: Benicia, Bethel, Rodriguez, Vanden and possibly Hogan.

- b. The Athletic Directors were not in favor of the joint double round robin because it would necessitate starting September 7, 2006 and have at least 1 week with 3 contests. Additionally, if Hogan fields a team, then SCAC may want to cancel the schedule.
- 3. The Athletic Directors agreed an adjusted League schedule should be made which has a triple round robin and 2 League tournaments.
  - a. Jay Dahl and Don Trolinger will work to create a triple round robin.
  - b. Each Athletic Director needs to inform their Principal about the change.
  - c. If any school has concerns about the new schedule proposal, please contact Joan Mumaugh, Commissioner.
