5.0 SECTION ITEMS

5.01 C. NEW BUSINESS (voting Items)

1. Sac-Joaquin Section Items

a. Proposed Budget for 2025-2026

President-Elect Santopadre presented the 2025-2026 proposed budget for review and discussion highlighting an increase to the budget from 1.656K to 1.856K. The budget was distributed to each league for their review.

b. Proposed Continued Success Movement - Winter Sports

Assistant Commissioner DeBoard presented this proposal which would make recommendations for the movement of schools up a division based on the Sections bylaw language for continued success in the winter sports of girls & boys basketball, girls & boys soccer, and boys team wrestling.

✓ Boys Basketball

- Stone Ridge Christian Boys Basketball: D6 by enrollment with a proposed move to D5.

✓ Girls Basketball

- Colfax High School: Proposed move to D2
- Faith Christian: D6 by enrollment with a proposed move to D5

✓ Girls Soccer

- Del Oro High School: Proposed to be locked into D1
- Ripon Christian: D6 by enrollment: no movement

✓ Team Duels – Wrestling

c. Proposed Increase to Section Cross Country Entry Fee

Assistant Commissioner DeBoard discussed a proposal which came from the Cross-Country Advisory Committee to increase the entry fee by \$2 for cross-country sub-section and section finals.

d. Proposed Amendments to SJS Bylaw 2207.8 (Football Payoffs)

Associate Commissioner Feuerbach proposed amendments to SJS Bylaw 2207.7 which originated with the football advisory committee; the proposal aims to shorten the season by one week and adjusts the SJS football playoffs brackets from 12- team brackets to 8-team brackets (#1-#8) + "Bowl Games" (#9-#16).

e. Proposed Addition of Two Person Pay Rate for Flag Football

Associate Commissioner Feuerbach discussed a proposal which originated with the officials committee; the proposal seeks to align the payment of flag football officials with other sports by adding the multiplier of 1.5, when a game has fewer than the recommended number of officials (3).

f. Proposed Amendment to SJS Bylaw 2700.1.C (Soccer)

Assistant Commissioner Lorensen proposed amendments which would include the addition of language to clarify that "Denying an Obvious Goal-Scoring Opportunity" ("DOGSO") be classified as a disqualification, not subject to an ejection / future game suspension.

g. Proposal to Move Vanden High School Girls Basketball to Division 2
